I am in the septic business and Ed dug for me . I grew up in Granite as well as Ed and we often discussed the changes that have occurred through out the years. Even though Ed retired in 2018 we would continue to talk on the phone discussing things like work, Politics and women. The conversations were suppose to take only a few minutes however would last sometimes an hour.

Ed would make me laugh and I would make him laugh.

One conversation with Ed was in 2018 when my father-in-law who lives in Florida had a stroke. My wife flew down however I could not get away until a couple days later. It was the first week of January and it was a cold day with temperatures 5 degrees below. As I was driving to Florida and listening to the radio when the DJ brought up the freezing points of coke/ beer/whiskey and Mountain Dew. After hearing the DJs statement I pulled over and put my case of beer out of the back of my pickup to the inside of my truck.

I recalled the DJ stating that Mountain Dew had a freezing point much lower then the other beverages around 15-30 degrees below zero. When I got to Florida I called Ed to tell him the DJ on the radios statement. Ed had told me earlier that he was not feeling well and was drinking 2 or 3 Mountain Dews a day and his daughter-in-law in the medical field told him this was not good for him. I told him he was drinking what was equivalent to anti-freeze. I think he stopped drinking Mountain Dew and felt a lot better. This was only one conversation of many through the years. Case and point Ed would make me laugh and I would make him laugh every time we talked.

He was not only a work colleague but also a friend.

I only learned of Eds passing on the day of his funeral. Had I known before I would have been there to pay my respects.

My family and I would like to send our condolences to the family of Ed Jones, and may he Rest in Peace and I am going to miss him.
